Dear Parents/Carers of children in Year 5 (from the Summer term) and Year 6,

Walking To and From School Alone Request

Children in Year 6 and those in Year 5 (after the Easter holidays) are eligible to Walk To and From School Alone, at parent's request. As part of our continual assessment of our safeguarding procedures we would like to ensure that we have an up to date register of all children who have permission to walk home alone. If you give permission for your child to walk to and from school alone, please complete the request details below.

In deciding whether your child is ready to walk to school you should read our 'Travelling To and From School Alone Policy,' assess any risks associated with the route and your child's confidence. We recommend that you work with your child/ren to build up their independence while walking to and from school through route finding, road safety skills and general awareness. There are many ways you can prepare your child to make an Independent journey. Children who are driven to school do not have the opportunity to develop road awareness and are therefore more vulnerable when they start to walk to school independently.
