- 187 parents completed the survey to say that they had received their child's school report.
- 56 parents made one or more positive comments.
- 2 parents raised a query specific to their child. All queries have been addressed with parents

Year 6 Exit Survey Summary

Parents/Carers of children in Year 6 were invited to complete an exit survey about their child's time at Barrowby School.

- 35 forms were returned, out of a possible 60 (58% response rate). Each response is 2.85%.

Just a suggestion, thank you.*
- *Thank you to all who have supported my son since he moved to Barrowby Primary School. The best decision we could have made with him, it has been great to see him flourish and regain his happy nature and cheeky smile.*
