In July 2019 we asked our 34 Year 6 children to complete a survey to help us to continue to improve our school, and the opportunities we offer to pupils. Not all of the children responded to all of the questions. Each response represents 2.94%.

### Being at Barrowby School

*'London Residential -Loved everything.'*

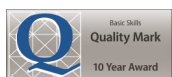
### Learning at Barrowby School

The only comments from children regarding what could be improved was that they would like more secondary transition days. This is unfortunately beyond our control and is up to the individual secondary schools.

We do however facilitate additional transition days for children that we feel would benefit from extra transition sessions due to their SEN/D/personal needs and will liaise with the appropriate secondary school and parents to facilitate.
