End of Year Parent/Carer Surveys 2016

Report Comment Sheets

Parents/Carers of children in Years Reception to Year 5 were provided with the opportunity to comment on their child's report. Year 6 parents had the opportunity to add comments to their Exit Survey.

- 68 parents made comments or raised a query. Some parents made positive comments, and also made suggestions or other comments.
- 56 made one or several positive comments.
- 9 parents raised a query specific to their child. All queries have been addressed with parents.
- 9 parents made other comments or suggestions, which will be taken under consideration.

Year 6 Exit Survey

Parents/Carers of children in Year 6 were invited to complete an exit survey about their child's time at Barrowby School.

- 31 forms were returned, out of a possible 34 (91.2% response rate). This is much higher than 2015, when the response rate was 30%. This year the questionnaire was sent out using Parentmail PMX
- In eight areas, all respondents (100%) indicated that they agreed, or strongly agreed with the statements.

These statements were:

The school has met my child's academic needs.

My child has been helped to achieve their best in numeracy.

The school is a safe and caring environment.

My child has been well supported at school.

My child has developed spiritually, morally, and socially.

My child has been encouraged to develop independence skills.

I have signed up for Parentmail PMX.

I have found the forms on Parentmail PMX easy to use.

- In a further 12 areas, one or two parents did not give an opinion, but no-one disagreed with the statements.

These statements were:

The school achieves high academic standards.

Pupils' effort and achievement are appropriately recognised.

Standards of teaching are high.

The curriculum is exciting and creative.

My child has developed an understanding of the wider community.

My child has been well prepared for secondary school.

*I have been well informed on safeguarding issues.
The school promotes healthy lifestyles.
Problems are dealt with effectively.
The school uses resources well.
Improved ICT facilities have benefitted my child.
The Parents' Evening booking system was easy and convenient.*

In the following areas, one, or two, parents (3.2% or 6.5%) disagreed with the statement.
No parents strongly disagreed with any of the statements:

- 1 disagreed that their child had been well supported in Literacy.
- 1 disagreed that they had found the information on the website helpful.
- 1 disagreed that home school communication was timely and effective.
- 2 disagreed that their child had been well prepared for secondary school.
- 1 disagreed that they had been well informed on safeguarding.
