



## Barrowby Church of England Primary School

### End of Year Parent/Carer Surveys 2015

#### Report Comment Sheets

Parents/Carers of children in Years Reception to Year 5 were provided with the opportunity to comment on their child's report.

- Of a possible 222 responses, 146 were received (66% response rate).
- 68% of those who responded made positive comments. 30% returned the form, but did not comment.
- 9 parents (4% of potential responses, 6% of actual responses) raised a query. The most common query related to the change in the way in which children are assessed. All queries have been addressed with parents.

**96% of parents overall either did not comment, or made positive comments.**

#### Year 6 Exit Survey

Parents/Carers of children in Year 6 were invited to complete an exit survey about their child's time at Barrowby School.

- 11 forms were returned, out of a possible 36 (30% response rate).
- 8 of the returned surveys (73%) indicated full satisfaction ('agree' or 'strongly agree') in all areas.
- Several Year 6 parents have written to school to express their appreciation for the quality of education, and opportunities, offered to their children throughout their time at this school.
- 2 forms (18% of respondents, 6% of all potential respondents) recorded a 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree' in one area. One respondent (9% of respondents, 3% of potential respondents) recorded a 'disagree' or 'strongly disagree' in several areas:
  - 1 disagreed that e communications were helpful
  - 1 disagreed that the school had encouraged independence skills
  - 1 disagreed that their child had been well supported in Literacy and Numeracy
  - 1 disagreed that the school promoted healthy lifestyles
  - 1 strongly disagreed that problems were resolved effectively.

**91% of Y6 Parents/Carers either indicated that they were wholly satisfied, or did not indicate that they were dissatisfied in any areas.**
