BARROWBY POST OFFICE TO CLOSE ITS DOORS FOR THE FINAL TIME

Barrowby residents have been deeply saddened at the news that the Post Office is to close permanently at the end of April.

There has been a Post Office in Barrowby for over 100 years, and Jennifer Pinner has been postmistress since March 2019. She has worked really hard to develop the business into more than just a Post Office, and during the Covid-19 lockdown period, Jen offered a vital service providing locals with groceries, essential items and the ability to maintain contact with loved ones far away.

However over the last year the business has been heavily impacted by several factors, not least issues related to Royal Mail strikes, and reduced services and support. Add to that the huge rise in energy costs, and Jen has decided that she can no longer continue to operate at a loss. Jen says she has been overwhelmed by the kindness of her regular customers, and on behalf of Barrowby residents we thank her for the friendly and dedicated service she has offered to Barrowby over her 5 year tenure. We wish Jennifer and her family well for the future.

To date there is no information as to future alternative postal arrangements for the village.
