## BARROWBY PARISH COUNCIL COMMUNITY INITIATIVE

The Parish Council wishes to thank those parishioners and village businesses and organisations that have already volunteered their efforts towards enhancing the appearance of the village.

In order that they can take this initiative forward, the Parish Council will be holding a meeting in the Reading Room on **Monday March 6**<sup>th</sup> at **7:30 p.m.** (tea/coffee to be provided) where they can explain which flower beds

are to be converted to perennial plants and which are to be maintained as bedding plants.

At this meeting the Parish Council will explain what volunteering will entail, and will organise groups to maintain particular flower beds.

It is planned to launch this initiative as part of Barrowby village celebrations to commemorate the Coronation of King Charles III in May this year. However, before then preparations need to be made in readiness for this summer.

#### **CORONATION CELEBRATIONS 6TH - 8TH MAY 2023**

Although His Royal Majesty King Charles III has expressed the wish that his Coronation should not be too ostentatious, the event will be a national occasion which will be recorded as a key point in the history of our nation.

The Coronation itself will take place in Westminster Abbey on <u>Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> May</u> and no doubt most of the population of the UK will witness this historic occasion from the comfort of their own homes on television. The Parish Council are making plans to hold an event on the village green on the Saturday, which they hope will include food, drink, live music and entertainment.

<u>Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> May</u> is designated as the day of The Coronation Big Lunch "at which neighbours and communities are invited to share food and fun together" in a street party style event.

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May (Bank Holiday) sees the day of "The Big Help Out"...... which will "encourage people to try volunteering for themselves and join the work being undertaken to support their local area." A number of village activities, including litter picking, the planting of a tree and launching the flower bed volunteer initiative are being planned for Monday 8<sup>th</sup>May.

#### **BARROWBY GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS**

- \* To help with seed sowing and warm compost, use a conservatory or greenhouse: buy seed compost as it is finer than multi-purpose and warms up quicker.
- \* Sow early peas and broad beans near the end of the month.
- \* Buy seed potatoes and leave in a light frost-free place to sprout (chit) before planting.
- \* Sweet peas soak overnight before planting to soften seeds.
- \* Sow an early variety of tomatoes at the end of the month for growing in a cool greenhouse that can protect plants from any late frosts.
