It will go out in book bags on Monday 28th February for children and parents to complete at home. To be returned by Thursday 3rd March along with an entry fee of £1.00 NB also has some really nice books that can be used as prizes for the quiz winners. All completed quiz forms with correct answers will go in to a draw and winners will be revealed by LB at Collective worship on WBD</p> <p>There will also be prizes for the best WBD costumes. Planning for fund raising activities to be supported in 2022</p>	<p>We need a sponsored event that all pupils can take part in as these are very good for raising funds for FOBS</p> <p>Suggestions included Assault course/obstacle course Skipping Scooterton</p> <p>It was decided a sponsored track event would work well. All pupils go up and down the 60 meter track 4 times in whatever way they wish. For example, skipping, running, hopping etc.</p> <p>The more creative way of travelling up and down the track the better and ask parents to sponsor their child to take part. Prizes/cups/medals awarded to the most creative ideas.</p> <p>Family Games Night A Family Games night to be held in summer Each round to have a different theme for example Bingo, Scrabble, Pictionary</p> <p>Refreshments and a raffle to be held.</p> <p>It was suggested to hold a Pic n Mix and Tuck Shop too. SS happy to purchase supplies from Booker and organise this.</p> <p>LB would like to reinstate 'Frozen Friday's' during the hot weather. FOBS to purchase Lollies and ice-creams and sell to the pupils on hot Friday afternoons. This will be advertised in advance so parents can send their child with the money to be able to purchase these.</p> <p>Film Nights LB would like to hold 3 film nights and will look at some available dates for Tuesday or Thursday evenings.</p> <p>They will run in the Hall straight after school.
