Review of Christmas events	Chair invited any comments about the events – everyone thought they went well and nothing obvious to change. Photo sessions worked better having small groups coming out of the hall for their photo. DVD – sound quality was poor & all filmed from the back of the hall, the cameras weren't good enough to get clear faces from that far away, Miss Sugden to feed back for next year.	
Sponsored event week	Week of 10 th February Miss Sugden asked for ideas for Mr Batey to take to schools council, where they can also put forward ideas KS1 – bean bags onto the Velcro target – 10 bags, targets number up to 10, sponsor per 10 points? (maximum = 100 points) KS2 – basket ball hoops – groups of 5 or 6, each has a basket ball & they take in turns to attempt a shot, 10 goes each, sponsor per hoop. Hula hooping – length of time the child can keep going e.g. every 15 second block of 5 minutes – sponsor per 15sec block. Sponsored spellings for every class – Have themed around endangered/extinct animals, sponsor per word Quiz – either send some facts home with older years then do a quiz & sponsor for each right answer, or set up a quiz based around school, maybe 4 rooms & send the children in groups to answer as many questions as they can (e.g. how many windows in a room, any date bricks – what's the date of the building, number of tables in the room etc) KS1 – collect a set number of items from outside e.g. leaf, pine cone, pebble – Miss Sugden suggested the teachers could put items outside for the children to find, perhaps linking in the the new learning stations due to be put up next week. Spring Concert	<p>Rosamund to confirm date with the church – either May 10th or 11th in the afternoon.</p> <p>No response to a sub-committee, by end of discussion agreed to ask Daniel Poole, Nisha volunteered and also ask Linda Curry who has expressed an interest in helping at FOBs but can't attend the meetings.</p> <p>Rosamund has asked Mrs Selby and Mrs Jarvis (parent) to perform, still awaiting a reply.</p> <p>Needs to ask Harrowby singers, Mrs Webster, High Notes, Kirsty has a relative who is an opera singer – to ask her. Also believe Mr Waghorn is in a group who may be willing to perform.</p> <p>School piano is difficult to get into the church, and Rosamund needs a piano player – to ask Mrs Tinkley or Mrs Rossington (parent), or Mr Waghorn.</p>	Rosamund to confirm date & organise sub-committee meeting
Summer Raffle	<p>Helen Linley had offered at the planning meeting to try to source raffle prizes. Becky to contact her.</p> <p>Discussed 'star' prize, spend around £100, talked about scooter, camcorder, argos voucher, tablet etc, Miss Sugden felt that electronic equipment was still a big draw for the children.</p> <p>If anyone has any contact with a company who might donate a raffle prize, please let us know.</p> <p>Michelle mentioned an auction of goodwill – discussed that that's an idea for summer fayre when all of school attend, rather than the music event which may not include the whole school, or may be held on several nights</p>	Becky
Cookery Book	<p>Had a sample that Anna Louise had requested, Becky to check on the website how quickly they turn around the printing, and what numbers we have to order to be profitable.</p> <p>Discussed how we can get the children involved – ask every child (KS2 may be as homework over Easter holidays) & ask them to hand in a recipe with a drawing or picture to go with the recipe in the book. It should be a healthy Cookbook.</p> <p>Depending on costs for printing and response from children, we could do a book per class, or per Key Stage to ensure maximum sales.</p>	Becky
