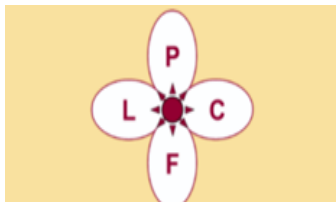
### LIASE
