Dear Parents/Carers

Well it's that time of the week again, where I find myself writing in the weekly Newsletter. As I always say, it's been a busy week this week, particularly for our Year 4 children who enjoyed their residential visit to PGL this week. It was a real pleasure to accompany the children and staff on this visit and I hope that the children enjoyed themselves and have learnt a little bit about themselves.

As you know, we are now getting to that time of year, when the children and adults will become more susceptible to the seasonal colds and coughs, that come at this colder time of the year.

To support parents, I thought it would be useful to clarify processes around illness. This week, we received an update from Lincolnshire's Health Protection Team where we were advised of how to support those with identified illnesses e.g. Influenza. It is important to emphasise that COVID has now been categorised as an Influenza.

You may know, that COVID testing is no longer recommended and should only be undertaken at the direction of a medical professional. Children and adults should no longer be regularly testing themselves if they suspect they have COVID. If they have coughs, runny noses, or are sneezing they should continue to come to school as long as they feel well enough in themselves.

While isolation is still recommended if you test positive for COVID it is no longer enforceable. The wording states 'stay at home if you can.' Further wording states that children should not go to school if they have a high temperature or are feeling unwell then they should remain at home.

It is difficult, particularly while we have lived through these times with COVID, but as long as we continue to be vigilant in school with handwashing, good personal hygiene, air flow and cleanliness of the school we will do all that is required at this time.

I spoke to the staff earlier this week about this.

If your child is feeling poorly keep them at home. If they feel well enough, send them to school. We are always on hand to support and can chat with parents on an individual case by case basis, if needed.

It is important that we all continue to look after each other, to support each other and offer a 'helping hand' where we can.

We are fortunate that our school family works well together, with patience and understanding.

I hope you enjoy reading this week's Newsletter.


