Dear Parents/Carers

We've made it to the final day of the term, can you believe it? The children have all worked very hard in school and we should continue to be very proud of them our staff and all they do.

While you're resting over the half-term and enjoying some time away from school, work continues in earnest.

This week, the work has started on re-modelling our school pond. On Tuesday the building materials arrived. The delivery driver was very skilled in operating the crane to neatly place the materials next to the school hall. The next day, the main contractor arrived and started to clear away the pond area of all debris.





This is a very exciting project and one in which we've been planning for a number of years. Yesterday, the paths were started to being laid, however, with the weather today that may seem too impractical to do anything more

However, the team will be busy over the half-term holiday, so we should see a lot more work completed by the time we all return after the holiday. I can't wait for the pond hard landscaping and dipping platforms to be installed.

In addition, I am pleased to announce that the school's car park gates will be 'automated' on our return to school. You may remember we were expecting this work to be completed over the summer holidays, but due to scheduling conflicts this was moved to this holiday.

Therefore parents should be mindful that the school car park gates will now remain closed. The school car park is a busy place and we would like to remind parents that use our Wrap Around Care provision that entrance to the school should be via the school's pedestrian path and that no parents are allowed to park their car in the car park.

Also, could parents that use the breakfast Club please refrain from parking on the zig zag lines outside of the school at the start of the school day. The School Safety Zone is in operation from 8.00-9.00am and from 3.00-4.00pm and is there to prevent any unnecessary accidents. As you are aware, Church Street is very tight and at the beginning of the day with staff coming to work and parents using the school car park entrance as a turning circle and parking on the zig zag lines, it can get very congested. Parents should ideally park way from the zig zag lines and walk their children to and from school.

We will continue to operate a one way system for drop off and collection for parents. The car park gates will be automated to open at 8.45am and close at 9.00am, as well as open at 3.15 and close at 3.30pm. These will be the only times the gates will be open. This should encourage all visitors to the school to use the pedestrian path which is provided and should hopefully avoid parents and children coming in and out of the car park gates when staff are trying to use the car park.

As you know, we continue to trial the change to footwear guidance, until the end of this term.

As the weather gets a little wetter, please feel free to choose whether or not your child walks to and from school in their black shoes. If you do decide it is not practical to travel in their school shoes, due to the weather, and decide to provide wellies or alternative footwear, their school shoes need to be brought to school, in their bag, so they can change into them. Also all children need their PE kit, both indoor and outdoor kit in school please, including their black trainers for out door PE. Thank you for your continued support. We will continue to trial this to the end of this term.

I appreciate your continued support in all that we do at Barrowby CE Primary School as we strive to ensure that everyone is treated equally and fairly.

I hope you have a lovely half-term holiday and look forward to seeing you in a week or so.


Parentmail

Parentmail is an online communication tool, you are automatically registered with Parentmail when your child starts school. Parentmail helps make life for parents much easier; with your App you can:


- View messages
