### Dear Parents/Carers

What a week we have all enjoyed, although be it a shorter 4 day week with the children. And we're in to the Winter now with the darker mornings.

Please may we remind parents that children should not be left at the school gate unaccompanied, at the start of the school day, unless they are in Year 6 and have permission to walk to and from school independently.

Over the last couple of days there have been a lot of Key Stage 2 children: Year 3 to 6 waiting on the school's pedestrian path unaccompanied by adults. Thank you to those parents that do wait with their children on the school path. Please be mindful that until the gate opens at 8.45am, children are still the responsibility of their parents. If parents have a Reception/Key Stage I child as well as a Key Stage 2 child please ensure the older child stays with you until the gates open. Thank you for your understanding.

You may have also noticed that the works to automate the school car park gate have now been completed. These works have been carried out to ensure that the car park is a safe environment. Parents are reminded that they are not permitted to use the school car park when dropping off or picking up from our Wrap Around Care Provision, but should park away from the school, avoiding the School Safety Zone (zig zags) and walk the children, using the school's pedestrian entrance, to and from school.

The car park gates will continue to be open during 8.45 and 9.00am and 3.15 and 3.30pm to facilitate the one-way system we have in place for our parents and children. However, from now on the gates will be closed at all other times. Once again thank you for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Unfortunately, due to inclement weather the works on the Pond Area and Outdoor Classroom have stalled, as the ground is to wet. I am optimistic that these works will start again and the works will be completed in a timely manner.

As we move forward as a school, we are continually refining and updating our school's provision. I hope to see many of you tonight at the Family Games Night, being organised by our FOBs team as well as next week's Parent/Teacher Consultations.


### **Parentmail**

Parentmail is an online communication tool, you are automatically registered with Parentmail when your child starts school. Parentmail helps make life for parents much easier; with your App you can:


- View messages
