Good afternoon all, as I sit here, the weather has changed again. Where's the lovely weather from yesterday?

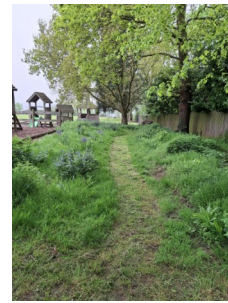
Despite the unseasonal weather the children are beginning to enjoy all that our outdoors have to offer. Indeed, I am thrilled to share some pictures of our school grounds:



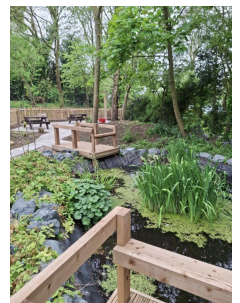
