## Parent Reminders

### Reception Induction Visit



Our first Reception Induction visit will take place on **Wednesday 5th June from 9.15am - 10.30am**. Children will be given the opportunity to experience some of the activities which they will encounter when they start school in September. During the session there will be a meeting for new parents in the main hall, to discuss your child's first year at Barrowby CE Primary School.

This will be an opportunity for new parents to meet members of staff, and a representative of the Friends of Barrowby School (Parent Association). We will also endeavour to answer any queries they have, and provide new parents with an information pack. Parents will be able to view samples of school uniform after the meeting, and try them on their child for size. We will also explain the online ordering procedure for school uniform.

The second visit has been arranged for **Wednesday 12th June 2024 from 1.30 to 3.00pm**, when we hope you will be able to leave your child in school for this session. We look forward to seeing you there.

### Year 6 London Residential Visit

Our Year 6 London Residential Visit will take place on Thursday 6th June - Friday 7th June. Children are to arrive at school for **7.45am for a prompt departure at 8.00am**.

#### Kit List -

- Pocket money to be brought in a named purse/wallet (£30 maximum). To be used for: souvenirs e.g. Tower of London, Matilda Program; ice cream during interval; light refreshment while at Harry Potter e.g. Butter Beer etc.
- Cameras (labelled) are recommended but please ensure that your child is aware that they are responsible for their own belongings. **Children should not bring mobile phones** – adults accompanying the children will have phones which can be used if necessary.
- A bag for children to carry their water, cameras e.g. Rucksack, PE Bag.
- For the visit, children should wear their full school uniform (including Barrowby School jumper/cardigan; skirts for girls, knee length white socks-no summer dress; trousers for boys-no shorts) and comfortable footwear.
- A waterproof coat or jacket.
- Packed lunch for Thursday including a drink, water bottle(s). Please send disposable items. Extra water bottles may also be provided (approximately 3 per day recommended).
- A change of clothes for the overnight stay e.g. nightwear, dressing gown, underwear etc.

Please ensure any medication e.g. travel sickness, asthma etc. is brought into school on **Wednesday 5th June 2024**, between 3.15 and 3.45pm. The adults who are accompanying the children will be based in the Year 6 classroom and are on hand to discuss any of the finer details for your child and can complete the necessary paperwork, with you. Please ensure you bring the medication form entitled, 'Administering Medication on the London Residential Visit' and that all medicines are clearly labelled in an envelope, with:

- your child's name
- required dose
- time to be administered

**If your child has medication in school, you do not need to provide a further supply of this, all medication will be taken on the visit with the adults accompanying this visit.**

We are very much looking forward to this memorable visit.



### Year 6 Visit to Church Schools Festival

Year 6 will be visiting Lincoln Cathedral, on Tuesday 11th June 2024, to take part in the annual Church Schools' Festival. The visit will take place within the school day but children will need to be at school for **8.20 am** for a prompt 8.30am departure.

In the morning the children will enjoy three activities:

- Choral Workshop
- Cathedral Tour
- Act of worship



After lunch there will be an Act of Worship. This will begin with a procession of school banners, with all schools receiving a candle to light and take back to school at the end of the day. We will return for the end of the school day at the normal time of 3.15pm.

Children will need to wear their full school uniform not the optional items (skirts or trousers for girls (no summer dresses or shorts) /trousers for boys (no shorts)) and to **bring a packed lunch**. 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




