Dear Parent/ Guardian,

We are delighted to inform you that Year 5 have been chosen to take part in an exciting day run by London's Royal Opera House called 'Create Day '24'! at St Wulfram's Church, Grantham.

This project celebrates the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. Starting with 6 hours of specially designed lesson activities in school, the project culminates on **Tuesday 2nd July** when schools across England will come together to learn and create a **mass cross-nation performance**. The day will be led by dancers and singers from the Royal Ballet and Royal Opera, both in person at the venue your school is attending and LIVE streamed from the Royal Opera House in London's Covent Garden so, as you can imagine, this is an incredible opportunity for your child. The visit will take place during the school day but children will need to be at school for **8.00am** for a prompt departure by coach at 8.10am.

Children will need to wear their indoor PE kit including: navy shorts, royal blue t-shirt and preferably black trainers with their outdoor PE provided in their bag in case of inclement weather.

Your child will also need to be provided with a **packed lunch** and a refillable water bottle. If you have ordered a hot school meal for this day and would like our hot school meal provider to provide a packed lunch for your child in place of this, please contact The Farm Kitchen on 01529 460821.

I am pleased to announce that this visit will be subsidised by the school.

You may wish to watch your child in person during the final performance of the day at 2.15pm. We recommend you arrive at the venue – St. Wulfram's Church during the 2.00-2.15pm break, so the children are not distracted as they prepare for the performance alongside the broadcast. The Royal Opera House Event Team will manage your arrival and find you a good place to watch from. Please note – there won't be seating in the venue, though chairs can be provided if there are specific access needs. If you are planning to watch the performance, please confirm by responding to the form provided.

For your child to participate in this event, we require your consent for filming which will take place at school on Friday 21st June and at the venue on 2nd July to include the national broadcast, there will also be posting on twitter from @ROHSchools and on their main Royal Opera House social media channels using #CreateDay24
