



## *Barrowby Church of England Primary School* Wrap Around Care Provision Survey – May 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

At Barrowby CE Primary School, we believe that:

*As a Church school family, we strive for excellence, ensuring that we all feel happy, valued and loved. We aim to provide an exciting, innovative, and relevant curriculum that enables all to 'shine' and develop as creative, respectful and independent citizens. We seek to promote equal opportunities for all so that each individual is encouraged to achieve their full potential and become lifelong learners who can make a positive contribution to society.*

As part of our continued 'strive for excellence' at Barrowby Church of England Primary School, we asked you to provide feedback so that we can evaluate our current Wrap Around Care Provision and its service to our school family.

As you are aware our school offers a Wrap Around Provision. This consists of Breakfast Club split into two sittings - 7.45am and 8.15am - and an Afterschool Club split into two sittings - 4.30pm and 5.30pm. Recently, the Government announced that it is their ambition that by 2026, all parents and carers of primary school-aged children who need it will be able to access term time childcare in their local area from 8am-6pm.

Therefore, in May 2024, we asked all parents to complete a Wrap Around Care Provision Survey to gauge whether or not we need to extend our After School Club provision. We received 157 responses. Each response represents 0.6% approximately.

**Question 1:**

Does your child(ren) currently attend our Afterschool Club provision?

*It is pleasing to note so many of our families use the Afterschool Club childcare provision.*

**Question 2:**

Does our current Afterschool Club finishing time (5.30pm) meet your requirements? If no, please select the time you would prefer the provision to finish.

<b>No – Would prefer 5.45pm</b>	1.3%
<b>No – Would prefer 6.00pm</b>	17.2%
<b>N/A – Child does not attend</b>	46.5%

**Thank you for your comments:**

*It is pleasing to note that of those that use the provision a good proportion feel that the current timings service their needs. However, as the results indicate 18.5% (31 pupils) of the respondents feel that lengthen the provision would better suit their needs.*

*Therefore, we will present this survey to the Governors who will be asked to evaluate the outcomes and to decide whether or not the provision's service time will be increased from 3.15 – 5.30pm to 3.15 – 6.00pm.*

As you will be aware, we are continually reviewing and evaluating our school's Wrap Around Care Provision. This term has seen the introduction of the use of Childcare Vouchers for those families that qualify which has been received well by those families that use them. In addition, we have purchased additional resources for the benefit of the children within the provision.

We hope to inform parents, in due course, of the Governor's decisions regarding this survey.

I look forward to working with our school family, as we continue to strive to enhance even further our provision and opportunities available to all.
