Dear Parents/Carers

Tonight, for those of you with children attending school, you should receive your child's end of year report. Please check their book bags. For those who do not have children attending school, arrangements have been made for you to collect your child's report.

Most of our parents will be familiar with our annual school reports. This year the reports include:

- Individual description of your child in their Personal Profile;
- Subject attainment for all subjects (or Areas of Learning in Reception);
- Subject effort grading, for all subject areas; and
- Next Steps/Targets clearly identified in English (or Literacy in Reception) and Maths.

Your child/ren(s) report will also include:

- * Individual Attendance Summary Report;
- * Individual 'Child's Results,' in either:
 - Reception Early Years Foundation Stage Profile
 - Y1 Phonics Screener Results
 - Y2 Phonics Screener Results (only for children who did not meet the expected standard in Y1)
 - Y4 Multiplication Checker
 - Y6 End of Key Stage 2 Teacher Assessments and KS2 SATs Results; and
- * Leaflet for 'End of Year Expectation for Standard' child has just completed (not Reception);
- * An evaluated copy of the most recent SEND Support Plan along with the proposed SEND Support Plan, which will be implemented in September 2024; for those children with identified SEND needs.

This year, we have continued to adapt our curriculum and the way in which we work with our pupils so that all our pupils continue to progress. We hope that this is reflected within your child/ren(s) report tonight.

Tonight, you may notice that your child/ren's report is slightly different. We have worked hard to ensure that what is reported to parents reflects our new curriculum and your child/ren's learning and covers your child/ren(s) standards in all areas of the curriculum, as well as making the report accessible.

When you receive your child's report tonight, please refer to the accompanying leaflet, "End of Year Expectations for: Standard 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6" to better understand the expectations of the 'Standard' your child has just completed.

As a school, when providing Teacher Assessment, we use a range of terms to communicate progress and/or attainment to date. These are:

BLW	Below	'below the standard of the pre-Key Stage'
PKF	Pre Key Stage	'Pre-Key Stage: Foundations of the expected standard'
WTS	Working Towards	'working towards the standard'
EXS	Expected	'working at the expected standard'
GDS	Greater Depth	'working at a greater depth in the standard'
HNM	Has Not Met	'has not met the required standard for their age'

Teacher Assessment is based on a wide range of school based evidence, including: observations of pupils e.g. attitude to work, discussions with pupils, individual assessments and most importantly, the pupil's work, on a day to day basis, in the classroom. Our staff work together to discuss their findings and agree a common expectation for each 'Standard.'

As well as that, we also provide effort grades for each subject:

AA	Above Average
A	Average
BA	Below Average

In this way, we can confirm, with parents, how confident their child is within the 'Standard' they are working in, referenced to the National Curriculum.

As a parent, you will want to be reassured that your child has continued to work hard and be happy in what they do at our school. Your child's teacher will have kept you up to date on their progress, at Parental Consultations, throughout the year.

We realise that parents may not fully understand this way of reporting or may have further questions. Therefore, to support our parents, we would like to provide an 'Open Consultation.' This year, we would like to invite all parents to our 'Open Consultation' on Wednesday 17th July 3.30 - 5.00pm.

This year, parents will be encouraged to visit the school hall to see their child's class teacher, should they wish to.

This is an 'open invitation' for those parents who would like to:

- discuss their child's end of year report, with their child's class teacher; or
- discuss their child's newly proposed SEND Action Plan, for September 2024 (if applicable);

or for those pupils in Year 5 to:

- view their child's 11+ practice papers (for pupils in Year 5 only).

There is no obligation to contact the school. If you feel that you are satisfied and understand:

- the content of your child's report;
- the SEND Support Plan (if applicable); and

then, I would ask that you respond to the 'Report Comments for 2024' on-line form, sent to you tonight, through ParentmailPMX to:

- acknowledge receipt of the report; as well as
- convey any comments about this year's report.

For parents of children in Year 6, tonight, you should also receive an on-line 'Year 6 Parental Survey' which I would ask that you complete so that we can continue to evaluate and further enhance the experiences for all pupils at Barrowby CE Primary School.

I would like to thank all members of our school family for their continued support and hope you enjoy sharing and reading your child's end of year report; celebrating all that your child has achieved and all that our school has to offer.
