Below are a few last minute reminders, for parents:

- All parents will need to complete the Medication Form which will be available from today, Thursday 5th September on ParentmailPMX.

Please could you kindly complete the form by **Friday 20th September 2024**.

- **If your child requires medication, please bring it into school between 3.15pm and 3.45pm on Friday 27th September.** This will allow us to ensure that all medication is correct; permission forms are signed by parents; medication is given to the adult responsible for your child at PGL and that parents have the opportunity to discuss any medical concerns, in person. **If your child has medication in school there is no need to provide a further supply of this, this will be taken on the visit with the adults attending.**
- All medication should be clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage instructions.
- Please arrive promptly at school, on Monday 30th September at 8.45 am.
- Please do not send your child with jeans, as they become very uncomfortable if they become wet.
- Please ensure your children have appropriate footwear such as wellies/ trainers.
- Children may bring spending money, but no more than £5 please.
- Children will be arriving back to school within the school day on Tuesday and should be collected as normal at 3.15 pm.

I am sure the children will have an amazing time and we are all looking forward to sharing our adventures, at PGL with you.

All kit should be clearly labelled with your child's name, and should be packed into a rucksack or holdall which they are able to carry themselves.

### **Essential Items**

- A sleeping bag and pillow
- Warm Jumper
- Trousers
- T-shirts/shirts
- Barrowby School Navy blue Outdoor PE Top
- School hats will be given to children for the duration of the visit.

Appropriate comfortable footwear (Wellington boots may be brought, please ensure they are packed into your child's rucksack or holdall)

Waterproof coat

### **Other Items**

- Washing gear (in a bag): deodorant (roll-on); Tooth brush etc.; Towel; Brush/comb
- Underwear and socks
- Appropriate Night Wear; dressing gown; slippers; 'Teddy' (small)
- Handkerchiefs/tissues
- Lip salve

### **Optional Items (These items are brought entirely at your own risk)**

- Up to £5 pocket money (optional) in a named purse/wallet
- Camera
- Books
- Comics
- Watch

### **Banned equipment**

- Any electrical equipment eg MP3/ipod
- Make-up
- Jewellery e.g. ear rings
- Mobile phones
- Sweets or extra food
- Aerosols e.g. deodorant
