Dear Parent/Carer,

National Holocaust Museum– World War 2

From September, our Year 6 topic is all about World War 2, and to conclude the children’s learning this term, we are planning to go to the National Holocaust Museum, Newark.

Pupils will begin with a tour of The Journey exhibition led by an educator. They will be taken through a series of rooms, each designed to authentically represent a time period in Nazi Germany between 1933 and 1938.

What is it like to be seen as ‘different’? What courage does it take to stand up for our friends against bullying? The children will take a journey into one of the most dramatic periods of world history, to help them think about identity, friendship and kindness in their own life today. This is an exhibit designed specifically for Key Stage 2 children.

The visit will take place on Monday 8th December 2025. Please ensure that your child arrives at school at 8:45am to allow a prompt departure from school at 9.00 am to the Centre. We are expected to arrive back at school in time for the end of the day 3.15pm. Children will need to be provided with a packed lunch and their water bottle with them on the day of the visit and be in full school uniform.

The cost of the visit will be £19.79. This can be paid through your Arbor App.

Payment is due by Friday 28th November 2025.

Please could you provide consent for your child to attend this visit, on the Arbor App by Friday 19th September 2025. By providing consent you are agreeing to pay the balance of the visit, by the date above.

How to give consent:

1. Log in to the Arbor Parent Portal or open the Arbor App.
2. Navigate to Activities.
3. Select Child Name: Trips
4. Select the Visit: Y6 National Holocaust Museum Visit
5. Select Sign Up and tick the box to provide consent.

In order for this visit to be financially viable, we do need a very high level of participation. In the event of insufficient support it is possible that the visit will not be able to go ahead.

Once we have gauged interest and confirmed final numbers for the visit, we will contact you with details regarding payment.

If there are any difficulties regarding payment, you may be eligible for a remission of the costs, if you are in receipt of qualifying benefits. We would also be willing to extend the payment period in certain circumstances, subject to a definite payment schedule being agreed. Please contact the school office for further information about this– any such enquiries will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
