### **Subject: Reminder Regarding After-School Conduct and Walking to and From School Agreement**

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have recently been made aware that groups of Year 6 children have been gathering at the local park after school and engaging in aggressive behaviour. This has raised concerns for their wellbeing and the safety of others.

Yesterday, Miss Lees and I visited the park and observed that some children were present without adult supervision, contrary to the expectations outlined in our Walking to and From School Agreement. As a result, parents of those children have been contacted directly.

This morning, I have reminded all children of the importance of going straight home or to an agreed pick-up point where a parent or carer will be waiting. This is to ensure their safety and to uphold the standards of behaviour expected outside of school and in line with the Walking To and From School Agreement which all parents have signed.

As per the agreement, you have indicated that your child will not be at the park unaccompanied after school. This agreement is in place to help ensure children's safety and appropriate conduct outside of school hours.

Unfortunately, if children continue to be unaccompanied at the park and are involved in inappropriate behaviour, we will have no choice but to withdraw permission for them to walk to and from school independently for those individuals.

We appreciate your support in reinforcing safe and respectful behaviour with your child and ensuring they are appropriately supervised after school.
