We are pleased to inform you that your child has been selected by Miss Lees (Assistant Headteacher for Behaviour and Inclusion) to take part in our Sensory Circuits Club. This will run each morning from 8:35 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. with Miss Reed, starting on Monday 12th January (the second week back after the Christmas break).

What does this mean for you?

Your child will need to be dropped off at school slightly earlier than usual, at 8:35 a.m. at the KS1 entrance, the hall side gate so they can participate in the session.

Why Sensory Circuits?

Sensory Circuits is a short, structured programme of physical activities designed to help children regulate their sensory systems and prepare for learning. It can:

- Improve focus and attention in class
- Support emotional regulation
- Enhance coordination and motor skills
- Provide a positive, calm start to the school day

If your child attends Breakfast Club they will be collected from the provision to attend Sensory Circuits.

To gain the full benefit of Sensory Circuits, it is important that your child attends regularly. Consistent participation helps them develop routines and experience the positive impact on their learning and wellbeing.
