On Friday 9th January 2026, we received another complaint from a local resident regarding parking near the school. On this occasion, vehicles were parked on Rectory Close in a way that blocked driveways, preventing the resident from leaving their own property. Unfortunately, this has happened on a number of occasions. I shared with the resident the link to LCC to report any issues relating to parking.

We kindly remind all drivers of their responsibilities under the Highway Code, which states that you must not park in front of an entrance to a property or in a manner that obstructs access. Parking considerately helps ensure safety and maintains positive relationships with our community.

Please note that any instances of inconsiderate parking can be reported to Lincolnshire County Council Parking Enforcement. You can find more information and report issues via the following link:
