### **Proposed residential visit to PGL Caythorpe - Monday 28th September - Tuesday 29th September 2026**

#### **What's it all about?**

It's about having fun while taking part in all sorts of adventurous activities designed to help your child learn and develop new skills and really shine as an individual and also as part of a team.

For many children this may be their first experience of staying away from home without you. PGL staff and school staff will be on hand throughout to encourage, reassure and help, so that your child returns home even more confident and independent with a real sense of achievement.

We would also be willing to extend the payment period in certain circumstances, subject to a definite payment schedule being agreed. Please contact the school office for further information about this - any such enquiries will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

If your child is not well enough to take part at the time of the visit (confirmed in writing by your child's doctor), all payments can be refunded.

We are very much looking forward to this visit with our Year 6 children.
