### Belvoir Cricket & Countryside School Days

On **Tuesday 23rd June 2026**, Mr Caton's class will be visiting Belvoir Cricket Club for a Cricket and Countryside Day .

The day will include a range of exciting cricket activities in the morning, leading into the afternoon where the children will have opportunities to take part in countryside activities like meeting animals from the estate, ranging from birds of prey, retriever dogs, the Belvoir Hunt Hounds, young pheasants and partridges. Other activities include fishing, orienteering, archery, meeting the Gamekeeper, the Sheppard and Teaching Trees from the Forestry Commission and an Outdoor and Adventurous team building session ran by the local armed forces. The children will take part in 4 different activities over the afternoon.

This visit will take place during the school day and your child will need to wear their Barrowby School Sports Kit and suitable footwear as well as bring a drink and a packed lunch, water will be available to top up during the day.

Should you wish to place an order for a packed lunch, our hot school meal provider, The Farm Kitchen will offer this option for you to order for your child. Your order will need to be placed by **Tuesday 16th June at 3.00pm**.

The cost for this visit is £12.84. This can be paid through Arbor from **Friday 27th February 2026**. Simply log in to your Arbor App for each child and scroll to the bottom of the screen where you will see **School Trips**, select the arrow. Once there you will see the products available for your child. Select Year 3 Cricket and Countryside Day and pay. Payment for this visit is due by **Friday 5th June 2026**.

In order for this visit to be financially viable, we do need a very high level of participation. In the event of insufficient support it is possible that the visit will not be able to go ahead.

If there are any difficulties regarding payment, you may be eligible for a remission of the costs, if you are in receipt of qualifying benefits. We would also be willing to extend the payment period in certain circumstances, subject to a definite payment schedule being agreed. Please contact the school office for further information about this– any such enquiries will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
