The SATs are National Curriculum Assessments that every child in Year 6 has to take.

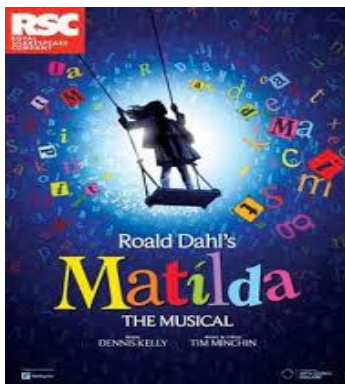
