As a part of your child's education at Barrowby CE Primary school we aim to promote safer use of computers, the internet and the ever-growing technological world we now live in. These risks are grouped into four categories:

1. Conduct: children's behaviour may put them at risk

4. Commercialism: children's use of platforms with hidden costs may put them at risk
