Dear Parents,  
**Year 6 Visit to London**

We are all very excited that tomorrow we will embark on our exciting visit of our capital city. Over the last few days, I have been following the weather forecast carefully and it looks like temperatures are going to be higher than expected from 28-33 degrees. To that end, I have decided to allow boy's to have the **option** of wearing their school's mid-grey tailored shorts for the duration of the visit and must ask that all children bring sun-cream and additional water bottles please so the children can remain hydrated. The school will provide your child with a navy blue Barrowby baseball cap if you do not have one.

Please ensure any medication e.g. travel sickness, asthma etc. is brought into school on **tonight**, between 3.15 and 3.45pm. The adults who are accompanying the children will be based in the Year 6 classroom and are on hand to discuss any of the finer details for your child and can complete the necessary paper-work, with you. Doing this the day before, will enable us to depart promptly for London, on time tomorrow morning.

### Kit List

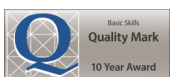
- Pocket money to be brought in a named purse/wallet (£30 maximum). To be used for: souvenirs e.g. Matilda Program; ice cream during interval; light refreshment while at Harry Potter e.g. Butter Beer etc.
- Cameras (labelled) are recommended but please ensure that your child is aware that they are responsible for their own belongings. Children should not bring mobile phones – adults accompanying the children will have phones which can be used if necessary.
- A bag for children to carry their water, cameras e.g. Rucksack, PE Bag.
- For the visit, children should wear their full school uniform (including Barrowby School jumper/cardigan; skirts for girls, knee length white socks-no trousers or summer dress; trousers for boys-no shorts) and comfortable footwear.
- A waterproof coat or jacket.
- Packed lunch for Thursday including a drink, water bottle(s). Please send disposable items. Extra water bottles may also be provided (approximately 3 per day recommended).
- A change of clothes for the overnight stay e.g. nightwear, dressing gown, underwear etc.

12.30 pm Explore the Southbank (street performers)  
1.20 pm River Cruise from London Eye to Tower of London  
2.00 pm Disembark and walk around to see Tower of London and Tower Bridge  
3.00pm Covent Garden  
4.00pm Rainforest Cafe  
7.00pm Matilda  
10.30pm Depart for hotel

6.00pm Arrive Barrowby

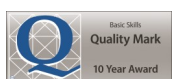
