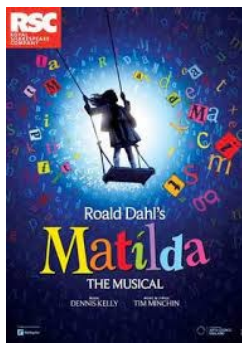

- 6.00pm Arrive Barrowby

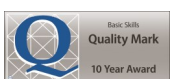


### Year 6 Secondary School Transition Dates -

We are pleased to confirm, after much discussion with the provider, the Year 6 Bikeability week will take place from -



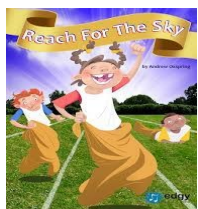
### Monday 4th July - Friday 8th July 2022

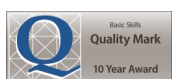


## Leavers Production
