Dear Parents,

Year 6 Visit to London

As you are aware, we are quickly approaching the time, when our Year 6 pupils will be enjoying their much anticipated visit to London. I thought it prudent to provide all parents with some quick reminders and an itinerary of the visit.

Kit List

- Pocket money to be brought in a named purse/wallet (£30 maximum). To be used for: souvenirs e.g. Matilda Program; ice cream during interval; light refreshment while at Harry Potter e.g. Butter Beer etc.
- Cameras (labelled) are recommended but please ensure that your child is aware that they are responsible for their own belongings. Children should not bring mobile phones – adults accompanying the children will have phones which can be used if necessary.
- A bag for children to carry their water, cameras e.g. Rucksack, PE Bag.
- For the visit, children should wear their full school uniform (including Barrowby School jumper/cardigan; skirts for girls, knee length white socks-no trousers or summer dress; trousers for boys-no shorts) and comfortable footwear.
- A waterproof coat or jacket.
- Packed lunch for Thursday including a drink, water bottle(s). Please send disposable items. Extra water bottles may also be provided (approximately 3 per day recommended).
- A change of clothes for the overnight stay e.g. nightwear, dressing gown, underwear etc.

We have provided you with a medical form for completion, this is to be completed on your Parentmail PMX. Please ensure this is completed by **Friday 27th May 2022**.

Please ensure any medication e.g. travel sickness, asthma etc. is brought into school on **Wednesday 15th June 2022**, between 3.15 and 3.45pm. The adults who are accompanying the children will be based in the Year 6 classroom and are on hand to discuss any of the finer details for your child and can complete the necessary paperwork, with you.

Please ensure you bring the medication form entitled, 'Administering Medication on the London Residential Visit' and that all medicines are clearly labelled in an envelope, with:

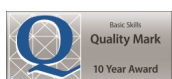
- your child's name
- required dose
- time to be administered

Doing this the day before, will enable us to depart promptly for London, on the following morning.

- 10.00pm Depart for hotel

Children will have a short time to unpack and then to sleep!

It is our intention to communicate with parents, via the ParentmailPMX text service, when we are in London with regular updates e.g safe arrival in London etc.

Please be assured that all members of the school staff (5 in total, including myself) will be carrying a mobile phone, as well as contact details for all children, in case of an emergency.

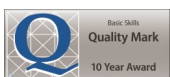
