### **Easter Holidays Revision**

Dear Parents/Carers of Year 6 Children,

As a school we recognise that our Year 6 children have missed a proportion of their schooling due to COVID 19 and want to ensure that we give them every opportunity to minimise this interruption. They have been working very hard in school to this end, but with the Easter holidays we thought it would be beneficial if the children were provided with additional homework tasks for this period away from school.

This afternoon your child will be coming home with an 'Easter Revision Pack' composing of :

- Maths book; a
- Reading book and a
- Grammar and Punctuation book.

In addition to this, Miss Lees has created a suggested revision timetable which can be viewed below.

Our recommendation is that the work provided should take no more than 30 minutes per day. The children are expected to complete the pages suggested in the revision timetable over the Easter holidays.

The children should be able to complete these tasks independently, but there may be some occasions where adult support is required. The revision books are expected to be returned to school with the children on Wednesday 20th April.

The revision pack will support your child/ren in their studies ready for the Year 6 SATs which are taking place during the week beginning the 9th May 2022, and their transition to secondary school.

As always, we really appreciate your support, and hope that the children find these revision packs helpful.

Please ensure the tasks are completed daily and returned to school on the 20<sup>th</sup> April. Good luck.
