Dear Parent/Carers

Your child has been working hard with Mrs Banfield to practise their race(s) for this year's Swim Gala competition, taking place on **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March**, and we are all very excited that the gala can take place this year!

Your child will need to arrive at the Meres Leisure centre to meet Mrs Banfield Band and myself **at 8:25am** at the front doors. Your child will join our school team in the changing rooms, supervised by Barrowby School Staff, and should be changed and be 'beach ready' no later than 8:45am . (The changing rooms will be very busy and we need to be on time to enable us to be pool side at 8:45am).

Each child will wear a Barrowby School swim cap (provided and loaned by the school for the competition) but should **bring their own goggles**.

The Gala will start at 9:00am and will be finished by 12 noon. We have organised a bus to transport the swim team back to school after the event.

Your child will be able to have **a water bottle pool side but no snacks** (unless there is a medical need). Please ensure your child has their usual school belongings with them e.g. their lunch, as they will return to school during lunch time.

Spectators – As per current guidance, Leisure SK have confirmed that there will be no restriction on numbers of spectators per competitor. Face coverings are optional and there is no need for a negative lateral flow test. It will be £1.00 entry fee per person. We do hope that some of you may be able to support our school's swim team.
