In Autumn Term 2017, we offered 18 arts related clubs (an increase of 2 from Autumn 2016):

- 208 places were allocated to pupils.
- In total 124 pupils (56% of the whole school) participated in an arts extra-curricular club in Autumn 2017.

#### Gender Analysis Autumn 2017

#### Key Stage 1

- Girls: 27 girls (66%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (an increase of 27% on Autumn 2016).
- Boys: 17 boys (63%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (an increase of 17% on Autumn 2016).

#### Key Stage 2

- Girls: 50 girls (64%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (a decrease of 6 girls from Autumn 2016).
- Boys: 31 boys (44%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (a decrease of 4 boys from Autumn 2016).

#### Whole School (Y1-6)

- Girls: 77 girls (63%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (a decrease of 4 girls from Autumn 2016).
- Boys: 48 boys (48%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity (an increase of 4 boys from Autumn 2016).

There were 38 girl's places (KS1) and 99 girl's places (KS2), in total 137 girl's places (a decrease of 7 places from Autumn 2016) were allocated to arts extra-curricular clubs, including girls who were doing multiple arts clubs.

There were 20 boy's places (KS1) and 43 boy's places (KS2), in total 63 boy's places (a decrease of 12 places from Autumn 2016) were allocated to arts extra-curricular activities, including boys who were doing multiple arts clubs.

- In total 138 pupils (62.7% of children in Years 1 to 6) participated in an arts extra-curricular club in Spring 2018.

There were 36 girl's places (KS1) and 130 girl's places (KS2), in total 166 girl's places were allocated to arts extra-curricular clubs, including girls who were doing multiple arts clubs.

There were 22 boy's places (KS1) and 60 boy's places (KS2), in total 82 boy's places were allocated to arts extra-curricular activities, including boys who were doing multiple arts clubs.

In Summer Term 2018, we offered 24 arts related clubs:

- 294 places were allocated to pupils.
- In total 143 pupils (64.7% of children in Years 1 to 6) participated in an arts extra-curricular club in Summer 2018.

- Girls: 33 girls (80.48%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.
- Boys: 15 boys (53.57%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.

#### Key Stage 2

- Girls: 53 girls (65.4%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.
- Boys: 39 boys (54.9%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.

#### Whole School (Y1-6)

- Girls: 86 girls (70.5%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.
- Boys: 51 boys (51.5%) participated in a variety of extra-curricular arts activity.

There were 91 girl's places (KS1) and 120 girl's places (KS2), in total 211 girl's places were allocated to arts extra-curricular clubs, including girls who were doing multiple arts clubs.

There were 28 boy's places (KS1) and 64 boy's places (KS2), in total 92 boy's places were allocated to arts extra-curricular activities, including boys who were doing multiple arts clubs.

In total, in Key Stage 2, 15% of pupils acted as Arts Club Leaders.
