Dear Parents,

As you may know, this past week we have had an increase in positive test results at our school.

As such we needed to implement a host of additional protective measures for our Year 6 class and have been closely monitoring the situation, not only in that class but across the whole school.

I am pleased to inform you that most of our Year 6 children will return to school by the end of this week, which means, as long as there are no further cases in Year 6 we will be able to remove the additional protective measures we introduced last week on Wednesday 24th November.

We continue to monitor all other classes and cases in school and will implement additional protective measures, if necessary, and in line with Government guidance and information from the Health Protection team.

Unfortunately, due to staff shortages please can I ask that you **do not**:

- come to the school office; and/or
- telephone the school.

At this time, I ask all our parents who need to contact the school to email the school office: enquiries@barrowby.lincs.sch.uk and ask for your understanding and patience.

The school will respond but it may take a little while longer at the moment.

If you do need to come to school to drop something off e.g. PE Kit, please feel free to leave it in the foyer with a note and a member of staff will collect it.

We will continue to limit the number of parents/carers that come into the school building at this time and ask that you email the school rather than coming to the office.

These are difficult times. But I believe that by working together we will prevail.
