PGL VISIT– 30th September and 1st October 2021

Dear Parents

As you will be aware, our Residential Visit to PGL is now very close and I am sure that the children are all very excited. We are pleased to confirm that the activities your children will be participating in are: Abseiling, Archery, Problem Solving, Zip Wire, The Giant Swing and an evening spent singing songs and star gazing around the 'Campfire.'

We have been informed by PGL that due to COVID regulations the children are required to provide their own bedding for their overnight stay. Therefore as part of their kit list could you please provide your child with a sleeping bag and one pillow.

Below are a few last minute reminders, for parents:

- **If your child requires medication, please bring it into school between 3.15pm and 3.45pm on Wednesday 29th September.** This will allow us to ensure that all medication is correct; permission forms are signed by parents; medication is given to the adult responsible for your child at PGL and that parents have the opportunity to discuss any medical concerns, in person.
- All medication should be clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage instructions.
- Please arrive promptly at school, on Thursday 30th September at 8.45 am.
- Please do not send your child with jeans, as they become very uncomfortable if they become wet.
- Please send your child's wellies in a plastic bag, clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Children may bring spending money, but no more than £5 please.
- Children will be arriving back to school within the school day on Friday and should be collected as normal at 3.15 pm.

I am sure the children will have an amazing time and we are all looking forward to sharing our adventures, at PGL with you.

All kit should be clearly labelled with your child's name, and should be packed into a rucksack or holdall which should also be clearly labelled with your child's name.

Essential Items

A sleeping bag and pillow

Barrowby School Cap (School caps will be given to children to borrow, for the duration of the visit, if they do not have their own).

Warm jumper (Barrowby School Navy blue outdoor PE top)

Trousers

T-shirts/shirts

Appropriate comfortable footwear (Wellington boots may be brought, please ensure they are packed into your child's rucksack or holdall)

Waterproof coat

Other Items

- Washing gear (in a bag): deodorant (roll-on); Tooth brush etc.; Towel; Brush/comb
- Underwear and socks including 1 long pair to 'tuck' into trousers when Quad Biking
- Appropriate Night Wear; dressing gown; slippers; 'Teddy' (small)
- Handkerchiefs/tissues
- Lip salve

Optional Items (These items are brought entirely at your own risk)

- Up to £5 pocket money (optional) in a named purse/wallet
- Camera
- Books
- Comics
- Watch

Banned equipment

- Any electrical equipment eg MP3/ipod
- Make-up
- Jewellery
- Mobile phones
- Sweets or extra food
- Aerosols e.g. deodorant
