Residential Visit to London – 8– 9 June 2023

As you probably know, we hope to be able offer our Year 6 children a residential visit to London, in the Summer Term, after SATs are over. In past years, this has been a wonderful experience for children and we would like to offer the same opportunity again this year.

The visit will include:

- 8.00 am Depart Barrowby School
- 12.30pm Arrive Southbank
- 12.30pm Explore Southbank and lunch
- 1.20pm River Cruise from London Eye to Tower of London
- 2.00pm Disembark and walk around to see Tower of London and Tower Bridge
- 3.30pm Jungle Cafe
- 4.30pm Covent Garden
- 7.00pm Matilda
- 10.30 pm Depart for hotel

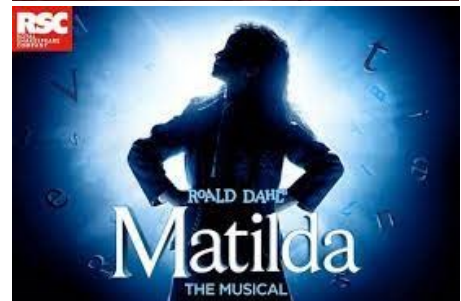
Friday 9th June 2023

- 8.00 am Buffet breakfast at the hotel
- 9.00 am Depart hotel
- 10.00am Arrive Harry Potter Experience for tour
- 12.30pm Lunch
- 3.00pm Depart for Barrowby
- 6.00pm Arrive Barrowby (approximately)

The cost of this visit will be approximately **£172.00**.

In order for this visit to be financially viable, we do need a very high level of participation. In the event of insufficient support it is possible that the visit will not be able to go ahead. If this should happen, your deposit will be returned to you. As hotel rooms and theatre tickets have to be booked early, it will probably not be possible to add on extra children at a later date.

The initial deposit is £30 which is due by **Friday 4th November 2022**. This can be paid by credit or debit card via ParentmailPMX or via the school office. Please note that, due to the penalties imposed on us for cancellation, payment of the deposit is a firm commitment for your child to take part in the visit. If payments are not made by the due date, your child's place will have to be cancelled.

If there are any difficulties regarding payment, you may be eligible for a remission of the costs, if you are in receipt of qualifying benefits. We would also be willing to extend the payment period in certain circumstances, subject to a definite payment schedule being agreed. Please contact the school office for further information about this– any such enquiries will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

If your child is not well enough to take part at the time of the visit (confirmed in writing by your child’s doctor), all payments apart from the first deposit can be refunded.
