## Reports

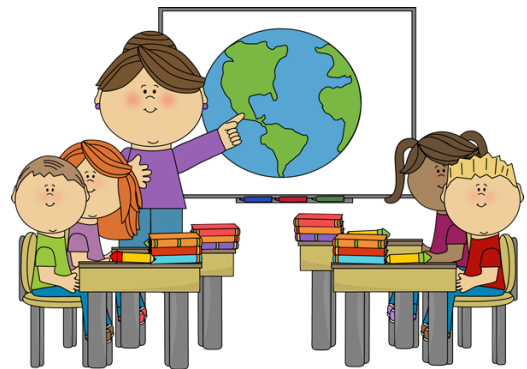
