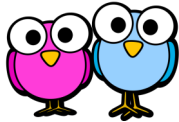

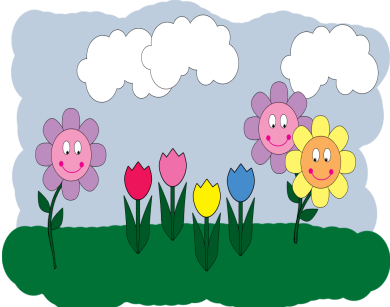

Events in School

Year 5 enjoyed a CSI (Crime Scene Investigation) day on the last Wednesday of the Spring Term, as part of that term's topic work.
