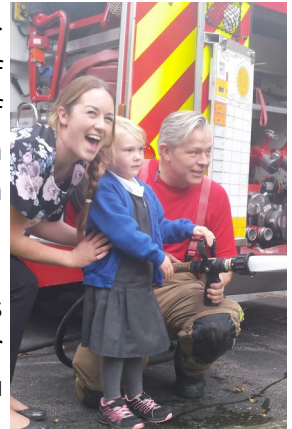


Grantham Fire Fighters Visit

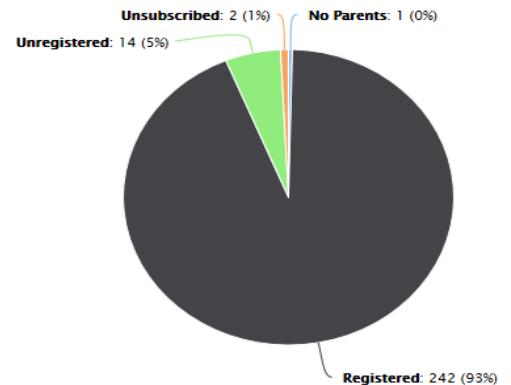


Gardeners - can you help?
