Parking and traffic

During the holidays, there has been some resurfacing work done in Church Street, which has temporarily covered the zig zag markings outside school and at the bottom of Church Street. We hope that these will be reinstated soon. Please do not park on the area directly outside school, or on the corners of Church Street, as this is a hazard to children.

This morning, we had a visit from the PCSO regarding parking. We would like to ask parents to be considerate in their parking on the bends on Rectory Lane and throughout the village, as this is causing a danger to other drivers who are having to then overtake on a blind bend.

Please park at the British Legion Car Park, and avoid bringing your car into Church St. Parents'/Carers' cars are not permitted in the school car park.

Uniform

Please see below a reminder of our school uniform.

Girls' Uniform

- **White polo shirt** - please note, no formal blouses
- **Mid-grey skirt or Pinafore dress**
- **Royal blue round neck sweatshirt or cardigan**
- **White socks** (no grey/black socks, please)
- **Flat/low heeled black shoes for indoor use** (not trainers)

Options for girls:

- *Medium grey tights (with winter uniform)*
- *Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored trousers with no external pockets i.e. not 'Cargo style.' Other styles (including legging-style trousers) will not be permitted.*
- *Royal blue & white checked/striped dress (Summer uniform: beginning of Summer Term to Autumn half-term)*

Please note that, although trousers are being introduced as an option for girls, our 'formal' uniform for girls is still a skirt or pinafore dress.

Boys' Uniform

- **White polo shirt**—please note, no formal shirts
- **Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored trousers** with no external pockets on the legs i.e. not 'Cargo style'
- **Royal blue round neck sweatshirt**
- **Grey socks**
- **Black shoes for indoor use** (not trainers)

Options for boys:

- *Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored mid-grey shorts with no external pockets on the legs i.e. not 'Cargo style' (Summer uniform: beginning of Summer Term to Autumn half-term)*

Please be aware that pupils are not permitted to wear:

- V-neck jumpers
- Light grey shorts/trousers/skirts
- Girls should not wear grey or black socks
