Remembrance

We marked Remembrance Day, in school today by holding a special remembrance assembly and held a 2 minute silence at 11.00 am.

Older children have made a Poppy Wreath, for Remembrance Sunday. Barrowby Church's service for Remembrance Sunday starts at 10.45am on Sunday 13 November and all are welcome.

Winter is here!

Although we avoided the snow this week, we have had some low temperatures. Please make sure that your child has a coat (and hat and gloves if necessary) in school every day. Some children are coming into the playground in the morning with their coats undone—please could you ensure that they are buttoned or zipped up.

Cars in Church Street

Once again, I must ask that all parents refrain from parking on the zigzag lines, or the school safety zone markings. If you park in these places, you are endangering both children and adults.

The Highway Code (Rule 243) states 'DO NOT stop or park near a school entrance.' From Lincolnshire County Council's website:

School Keep Clear' 'Zig-Zag' markings (£70 fine)

Stopping on zig-zag markings outside school entrances is inconsiderate and potentially dangerous. Keeping the road clear outside schools gives children a clear view in both directions before crossing. The restrictions are displayed on nearby signs and will be enforced.'

There is no need for parents to bring cars into Church Street at all, as there is parking available a few minutes away at the British Legion. As ever, thank you to those parents who put safety first, and park well away from the school entrance.
