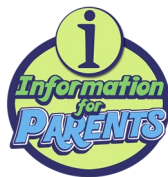

Notice from Lincolnshire Police

I don't know if you are aware or not, but there seems to be an increase of incidents of sightings of people dressing up as clowns. The reports vary from low level sightings, to more concerning reports of children being chased by clowns.

Girls' Uniform

White polo shirt*

Mid-grey skirt or Pinafore dress*

Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan*

White socks (no grey socks, please)

Flat/low heeled black shoes for indoor use (not trainers)

Options for girls:

- *Medium grey tights (with winter uniform)*
- *Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored trousers with no external pockets i.e. not 'Cargo style.' Other styles (including legging-style trousers) will not be permitted.*
- *Royal blue & white checked/striped dress (Summer uniform: beginning of Summer Term to Autumn half-term)*

Please note that, although trousers are being introduced as an option for girls, our 'formal' uniform for girls is still a skirt or pinafore dress.

Boys' Uniform

White polo shirt*

Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored trousers* with no external pockets on the legs i.e. not 'Cargo style'

Royal blue sweatshirt*

Grey socks

Black shoes for indoor use (not trainers)

- *Plain mid-grey, straight-legged, tailored mid-grey shorts with no external pockets on the legs i.e. not 'Cargo style' (Summer uniform: beginning of Summer Term to Autumn half-term)*

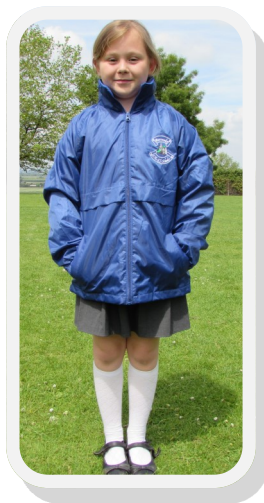

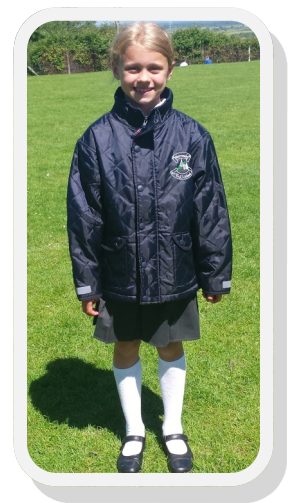
