What a Mesh!

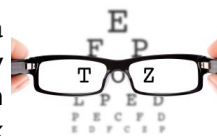

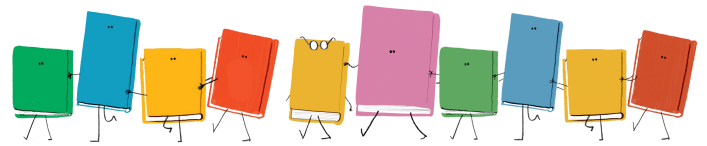
