Summer Fair

Everyone enjoyed the performances from the drama group, school orchestra, dance group as well as the school choir who were joined by past pupils for a spur of the moment collaboration.

The children had been busy all week making various produce to sell on their class stalls and we also enjoyed a BBQ, bouncy slide, raffle and Mr Batey in the stocks!

It was a fantastic evening and we raised an incredible £3527.37 for projects to improve our school for all of our children to enjoy. Thank you one and all for all your support.

Year 5 & 6 Buddy Challenge Workshop

This Tuesday, 9th July, our Year 5 and 6 classes were joined by Steve from the NSPCC to deliver a 'Steak Out, Stay Safe' workshop.

During the session the children explored different types of abuse, such as neglect and emotional abuse, and explored different signs of how to spot these types of abuse. Following this they discussed the different support mechanisms in place and how to report different types of abuse to a trusted adult or Childline.



The children then reflected on the people around them that help keep them feeling safe and happy as well as the places they feel most secure. All children received a 'Big Buddy Challenge' booklet complete with a paper 'chatter box' to help consolidate what they learned about Childline and the NSPCC.

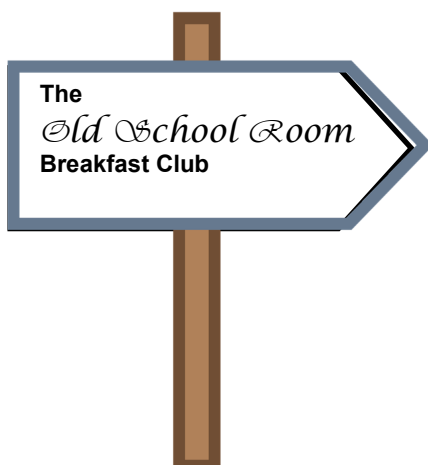
