Mr Caton and Mr Woolerton's Class Visits

On Tuesday 11th and Wednesday 12th June, the Year 4 classes visited the International Bomber Command Centre in Lincoln. The visit was to support their topic 'Pack up your Troubles'. During the visit the children played 'history detectives' and were able to hold and learn about artefacts from a bomber plan that had been shot down over Holland during World War Two. These ranged from a fire axe, for the breaking of the cockpit glass, to the actual headgear worn by an aerial gunner. The children were also lucky enough to dress in official R.A.F. uniforms from the time.



There was also a time for reflection as they studied the memorial spire and the names of the servicemen and women who sacrificed their lives during the conflict. Whilst in the exhibition centre itself the children had the opportunity to fly a Lancaster Bomber on a virtual mission. All of the children enjoyed the visit and found it a valuable learning experience. Special thanks to the staff and parents who accompanied the children, without them it would not be possible.
