Health and Safety Update

On Monday 12th November, we had a Health and Safety audit by Lincolnshire County Council and they were very impressed with the measures and policies that the school has in place to ensure the safety of children and adults.



- As part of our duty of care we would like to remind parents about the school car park:
- Children should not walk through the car park unaccompanied by an adult and adults should remain with their child until they have been admitted to the school premises by a school adult.
 - No cars (other than by pre-approval of the Head teacher) should use the school car park at any time.
 - Pedestrians should enter the school via the pedestrian gate and not by the car park gate which should remain closed during the school day.
 - Pedestrians should use the footpath and not walk on the grass.
