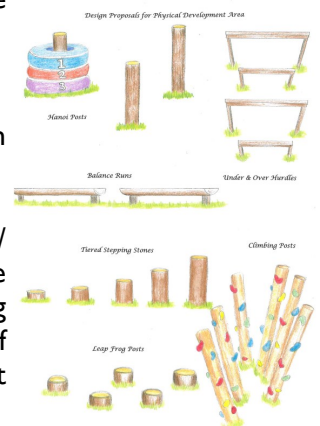

Consultation on admissions policies for 2020 intake

The School Admissions Code 2014 requires admission authorities wishing to make changes to their arrangements to undertake a 6 week consultation between 1 October 2018 and 31 January 2019.

Lincolnshire County Council, as the admission authority for Community and Voluntary Controlled schools, will consult on changes to its admission arrangements for schools beginning on 5 November 2018. This timing means that the whole of the consultation will fall in school term time.

Lincolnshire County Council are proposing to change the admission number of Barrowby Church of England Primary School from 34 to 30 for the 2020 intake. Their detailed proposals have been posted on their website at www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/admissionsconsultation. There is also a survey for parents to complete to have their say on this proposed change to the admission number.
