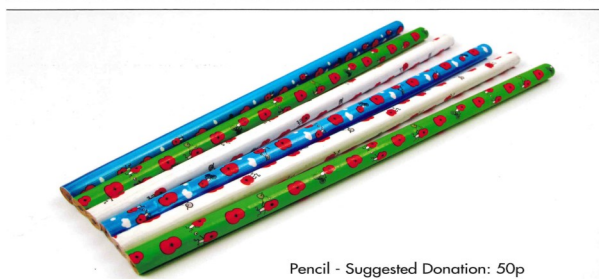
Eraser - Suggested Donation: 50p



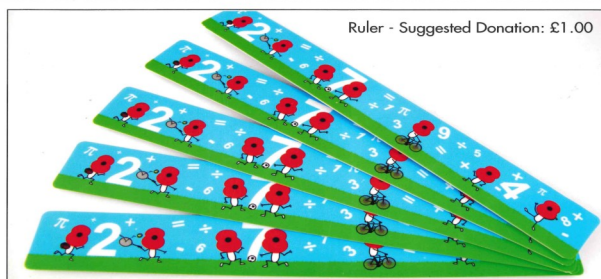
Reflector - Suggested Donation: 50p

We have been asked by Lincolnshire County Council to remind parents of children starting in reception in 2019 to apply for their place.

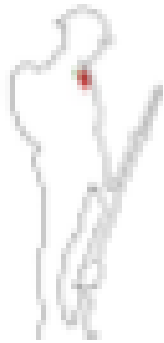

The main closing date is 31 October 2018, although the online and telephone application facility should still be available to use until 14 December 2018.

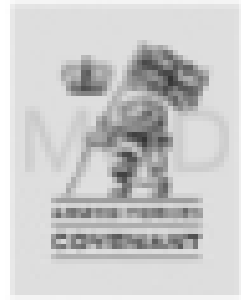
Churchyard Behaviour
