Events In School Uniform Reminders

Please could we take this opportunity to remind parents that children should be wearing their school winter uniform. This consists of: girl's-a **knee length**, mid grey skirt/pinafore and mid-grey tights with optional mid-grey trousers; boys-mid-grey trousers.
