Mr Batey and Mrs Midgley were very impressed with the professional way that the foodbank is run. They were also moved and saddened when told of the number of families relying on this provision to feed their families - on Monday alone they were expecting over 80 families to be collecting a food package.

Thank you to everyone for their kind donations. We will be endeavouring as a school to do more over the coming year to support Grantham Foodbank.
